



BOOK CHARGE INFORMATION FOR FINANCIAL AID STUDENTS Fall 2017 Term

To be eligible to charge books and supplies:

1. Must have grants and/or loans in excess of your tuition and fees.
2. To view: MyBTC > Paying for College > [Messages from the Financial Aid Department](#)
 - a. You may view your eligibility beginning 5 PM August 11, 2017.
 - b. If eligibility is not showing by this time, please stop by financial aid office.
3. Register for classes by noon on August 11, 2017.

To purchase books with financial aid you have 2 options:

1. Purchase Online
 - a. Begins August 12, 2017.
 - b. Log into MyBTC > Paying for College > [Order Books Online](#)
 - c. You will need your Student ID number.
2. Purchase/Rent on Central Campus
 - a. Begins August 14, 2017 – September 1, 2017
 - b. Must have picture ID
 - c. Bring current schedule so Bookstore staff can help you find your books.
 - d. Only good for books and supplies from the Blackhawk Bookstore.
 - e. If you need additional funds, please stop by the financial aid office for request.
 - f. Renting textbooks is an option with a debit or credit card. For more details visit www.btc.bkstr.com.

After you have charged your books:

- Keep a copy of receipt in case you need to return items.
- The amount you charged will be added to your student account
- If you make a return, in most cases a credit is applied to your student account.
- If you are not eligible for financial aid, it is your responsibility to pay any book store charges.

If you do not have financial aid awarded, eligibility not showing or sign up for classes after above deadline, please stop by the Financial Aid Office to determine if you are eligible for an EHART loan.
