Blackboard Collaborate Ultra:

Pre-load content

Load content before class, and keep it in session: Now moderators can prep for class at the beginning of the week, or even at the start of the semester! Moderators can open the Collaborate Room (from any course) at any time and load the files they want to share. These files stay in the "room" until deleted by a moderator. Load them once and reuse them as often as you want.

Better recordings quality

Enjoy better quality in your recordings. Blackboard has applied better smoothing and a higher bit rate to improve the quality of text in recordings with shared applications.

Owickly Attendance Tool

- 1. You will have options beyond just "Present" or "Absent"
 - a. For example: Tardy could be worth 90% of the days points and be considered 33% of an absence (3 tardies = 1 absence)
 - b. System Admins can set up these statuses and even allow faculty to create their own.
- 2. **Excused Absences**: A new attendance type that shows as an absence but is omitted from being counted against them when totaling the student grade.
- 3. **Comments** Associated with absence: Keep track of information related to the student's absence with a comment.

- 4. Absence **Stats** for a course: At a glance, see aggregate information about which students have been missing class the most.
- 5. Ability to take attendance **multiple times per day**: Have a lab and class the same day? Take attendance for both.
- 6. Ability to delete a date column: You'll no longer need to "reset" attendance for a day to delete the column.
